BLUE MARK is a concentrated blue marker dye to aid in showing visual spray patterns when applied to tank mixes on applications including turf, ornamental, and agricultural sprays. BLUE MARK aids in reducing spray overlap while also indicating drift patterns. BLUE MARK is excellent for use with fungicides, insecticides, herbicides, pesticides, and fertilizer applications.

RATE:

Add to all water based solutions at a rate of 8-16 oz/per 100 gallons of spray solution. Higher rates will darken the spray pattern. Adjust rates as needed for visual indication.
