CROP SOURCE 0-0-9 is compatible with most fertilizers and pesticides, however, a compatibility test is recommended if the desired combination has not been used in the past.

#### **Directions for Use**

**CROP SOURCE 0-0-9 c**an be applied foliar, direct soil application or through any type of irrigation system. Check compatibility with a jar test prior to mixing.

### **General Recommendations**

Cotton:Apply 2 – 4 qts/acre/application.Peanuts:Apply 2 – 4 qts/acre/application.Soybeans:Apply 2 – 4 qts/acre/application.
